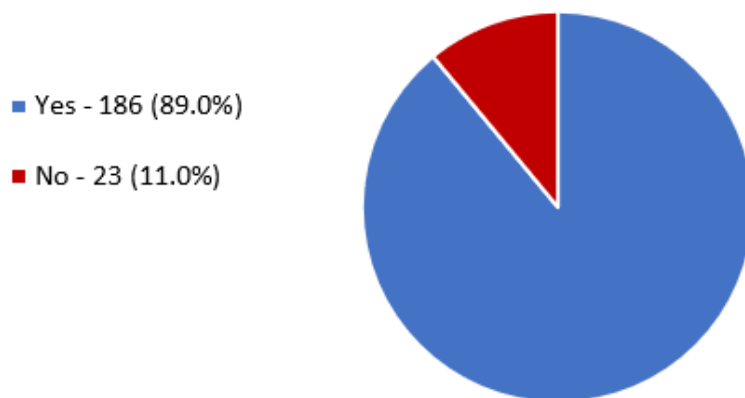

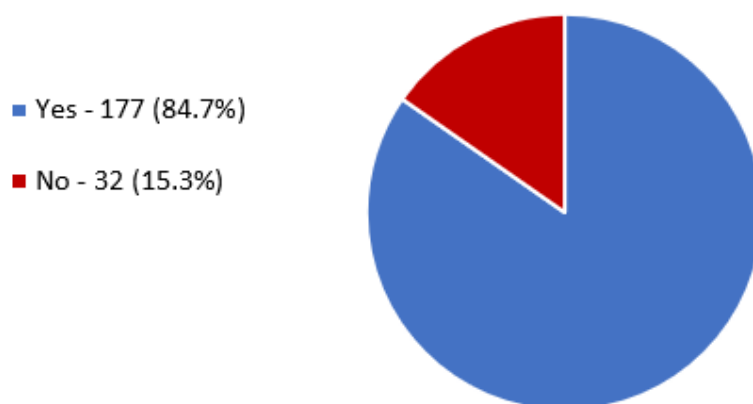

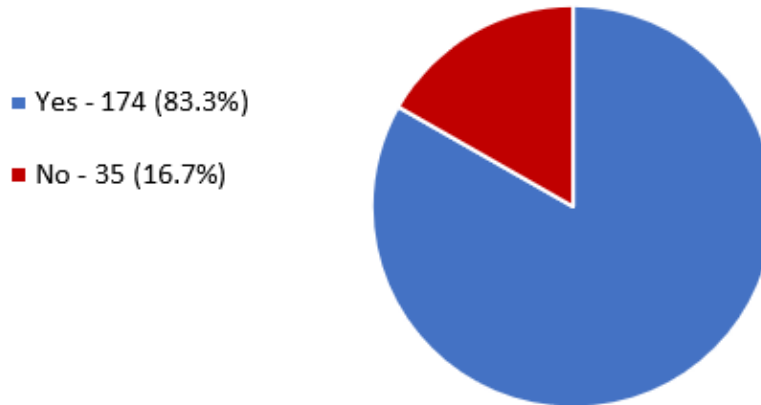
2. An unlimited number of stoppages of the performance of all work by one or more UFU members for the duration of 2 hours?

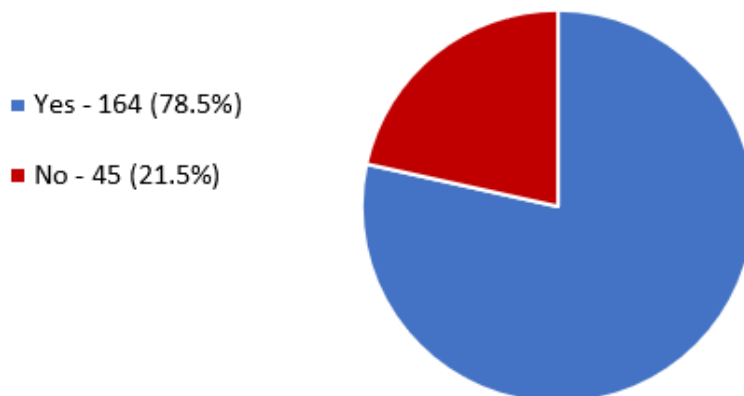
